Psalms 19:7-11 “⁷ The Law of the Lord is **perfect**, refreshing the soul. The statutes of the Lord are **trustworthy**, making wise the simple. ⁸ The precepts of the Lord are **right**, giving joy to the heart. The commands of the Lord are **radiant**, giving light to the eyes. ⁹ The fear of the Lord is **pure**, enduring forever. The decrees of the Lord are **firm** and all of them are righteous. ¹⁰ They are more **precious** than gold, than much pure gold; they are **sweeter** than honey; than honey from the honeycomb. ¹¹ By them your servant is warned; in keeping them there is great reward.” (NIV)

Romans 8:5-8 “⁵ Those who are dominated by the sinful nature think about sinful things, but those who are controlled by the Holy Spirit think about things that please the Spirit. ⁶ So letting your sinful nature control your mind leads to death. But letting the Spirit control your mind leads to life and peace. ⁷ For the sinful nature is always hostile to God. It never did obey God’s laws, and it never will. ⁸ That’s why those who are still under the control of their sinful nature can never please God.” (NLT)

(a) Think _____.

Romans 12:1-2 “¹ Therefore, I urge you, brothers and sisters, in view of God’s mercy, to offer your bodies as a living sacrifice, holy and pleasing to God—this is your true and proper worship. ² Do not conform to the pattern of this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind. Then you will be able to test and approve what God’s will is—His good, pleasing and perfect will.” (NIV)

Philippians 4:8 “... whatever is true, whatever is noble, whatever is right, whatever is pure, whatever is lovely, whatever is admirable—if anything is excellent or praiseworthy—think about such things.” (NIV)
